


This is to state that 'Impact of COVID-19 in Rural India: A Cross-sectional Study from 12 States' was carried out jointly by JRDS -- Development Programs, 10, Institutional Area, Lodhi Road, New Delhi –10003, and Indian Social Institute, New Delhi, 10, Institutional Area, Lodhi Road, New Delhi-110003, from June 2021 to January 2022. This study was carried out from the perspective of the marginalised communities like the Dalits, Adivasis, women and children. The study focused on livelihood, children's education, health, and social security schemes. The research study conducted in 12 states, had a total sample size of 5210, covering 474 villages in 46 districts. This study was funded by Indian Social Institute. The study was completed successfully.
