The training series equipped participants with practical Word-Press skills, enabling them to create and organize website content with confidence.

Through interactive demonstrations and hands-on exercises, participants developed practical website skills, strengthening digital communication and enhancing organizational visibility online.

JRDS Strengthens Digital Capacity Through Website Education Series

JRDS–Development Programs, through the Conference Development Office (CDO), conducted the third and fourth sessions of its Website Education Series, strengthening participants' digital communication and website skills.

The online trainings introduced WordPress fundamentals and practical webpage creation, enabling participants to confidently manage organizational websites and improve their institutions' digital presence.

Residential Program Promotes Safe Migration Awareness

A two-day residential programme introduced 65 participants to safe migration practices, labour rights, welfare entitlements, and essential government services through interactive discussions and informational resource materials.



National Workshop Prepares Trainers for Right to Work Initiatives

A national-level Training of Trainers brought together 34 participants from 15 states, fostering collaboration and preparing trainers to advance Right to Work initiatives across communities.



Participants gained practical knowledge to support Right to Work implementation, helping marginalized communities better access employment entitlements through informed guidance and coordinated local action.

Community Wellbeing Across Kalimpong

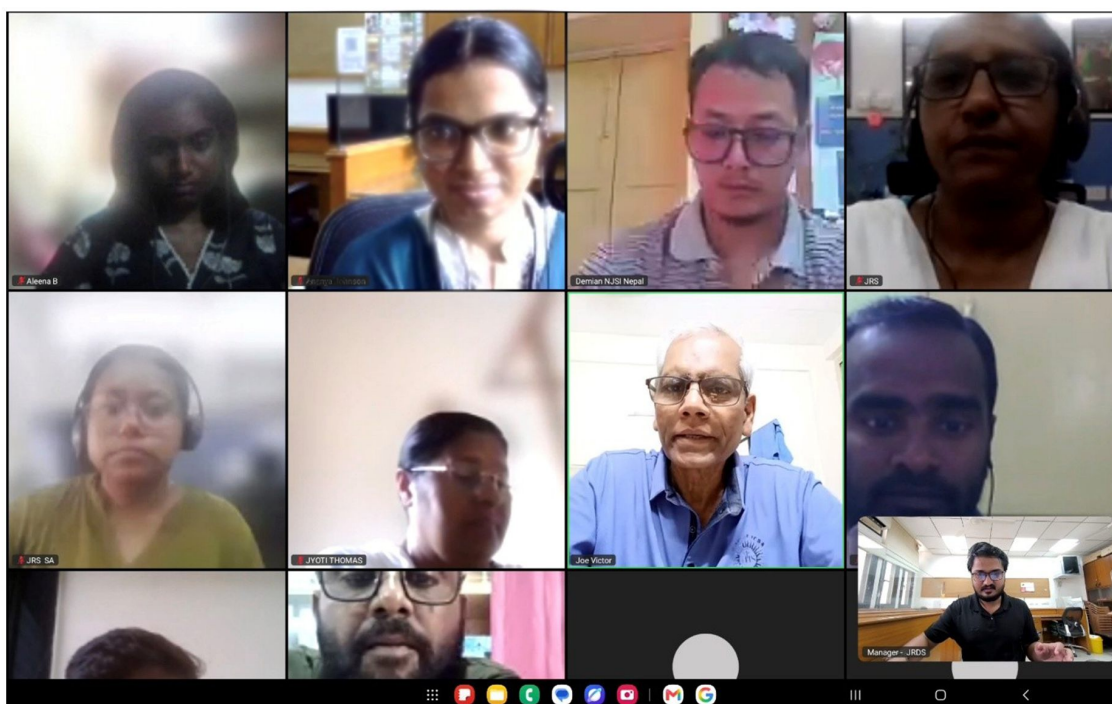

The Migrant Assistance & Information Network promotes uninterrupted education by connecting migrant children with schools, families, and local support systems for continued learning.

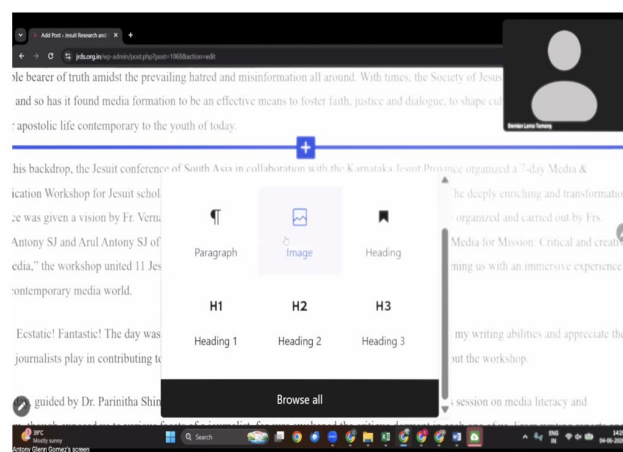
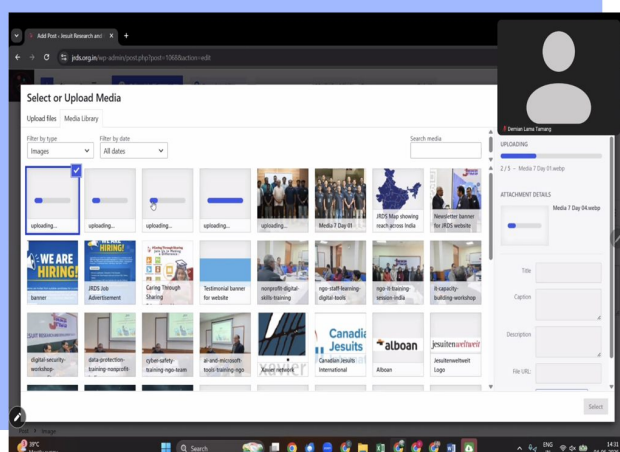
Through coordinated efforts, migrant students receive access to educational opportunities, essential support services, and an inclusive environment that encourages learning and overall development.
